Topics of Business

- 1) **Approve Minutes from July's Meeting:** Teresa voted motion and Coach Howell seconded
- 2) **Treasurer report:** There has been great support from our sponsors this year bringing in more monies then budgeted. There are a couple of donations that the booster club is still waiting to come in (Wells Fargo, and Sams Club). There are also a couple of expenditures that will be coming due soon. Over all, the financial standing of the Booster Club this year is looking good.
- 3) **Moo-Poo:** There has been a lot of talk about potentially hosting a Moo-Poo event for this year as a fundraiser. However, after much consideration of the time, space, location and potential profit from the event the board placed the Moo-Poo event up for a vote. Its was voted by Stacey R., and seconded by Lauren R., and Kim B., that the moo-poo even would not happen this year. It may still be an opportunity for next year if the construction status at FHS is a little different.
- 4) **Homecoming:** The Booster Club will be making a flier and will send it out with football players to provide an opportunity for families to by a "Mum". A Mum is to given to the mothers of players so that they can be worn on the night of Homecoming. We are working with Cara to make 50 Mums this year. They will be on a first come first serve basis.
- 5) **Floats:** Kim Bell is working with the Polancos and also Patty Thorton on the upcoming float. The Polancos have volunteered to provide trucks for the float/floats. Patty Thorton will be helping Kim with decorations and ideas for the floats this year.
- 6) **Teacher Recognition Shirts:** It is important that teachers and other members of the school board staff show support for PV especially while at our football games. One way to provide teachers the opportunity to support the PV Football team is providing them with a teacher appreciation/recognition shirt. These shirts are given by the players of our football team to a teacher who has made a difference or impact in that athlete's lives thus far. The teachers can proudly wear these shirts to the games knowing that their shirts are one of a kind. All attendees of the meeting tonight voted that the Booster Club should work on getting these shirts ready for teachers and members of the central office.
- 7) **The PV Football Fan Gear** orders are in and delivery of items will be 9/8/16. The Booster Club's profit from the sales totaled \$672.00

8) **Mailing Fundraiser:** May prove to be a great fundraiser geared towards those family members and friends that live outside our community who may want to support the PV Football program. This fundraiser will be discussed more in the future months.

Eventually the Booster Club would like to have an "equipment exchange" where parents or students can post pictures of equipment/clothing/shoes that they have outgrown or no longer use to make them available to other athletes who may need them. There is also a digital program available on the website with web links to each business who has helped sponsored this year.

10) **Game Time:** There are Saturday Morning film review meetings that take place for Varsity players. Breakfast is provided at these meetings. So far McDonald's has offered to donate breakfast for three of the Saturday's this Season. We are still in need of volunteers who will donate food for other Saturday mornings. Chick-fil-a has been contacted as well as a potential sponsor/donor. We are still waiting their return call.

Sundance Dental is our 1st Down Sponsor for the game on September 16. Sundance Dental is hosting a FREE tailgate party for anyone who comes. They will be providing food and snow cones. The tailgate party will be in front of the administrative office before the game.

The 1st District Game against Cibola is 10/7/16. The PVHS Booster Club wants to GO BIG and GO BLUE! We are still looking into ways that we can show our school pride and GO BLUE to make that game extra special. There may be a need for sponsors during this game to help make the GO BIG and GO BLUE event happen.

The PVHS Booster club is working on a **Punt-Pass-Kick** event to take place at half time during the 10/7/16 game. Details this event are still developing.

Referee snacks- Referee snacks usually include gatorades and some type of snack or meal that can be eaten during the half time. Snack details are still being worked on.

As a reward to all the player's hard work with selling discount cards there will be a team bonding ice party. Dates will be determined by Coach Howell with details to evolve at that time.

Coach Report: The PV Football team has received some portables out by the PV football field to use as temporary dressing room/lockers. In the seasons to follow there will be need for some type of shelving units, hangers and chairs for the players. Maybe with the help of the PV Football Booster club this might take place. Discussions still need to take place.

Coach Howell also mentioned another possible fundraiser for next year is a "Red Zone Sponsor". The Booster Club will discuss this fundraising opportunity in the future.
